Have you signed up? This system will allow public officials in Dickinson County to send out alerts directly to you. These alerts can be sent via e-mail, text message, or by an actual phone call. When you register you can choose which weather alerts you wish to receive. Aside from weather alerts this also allows each city the capability to send alerts to their residents such as planned power outages, water or gas issues, public notices, etc. If you have not registered, check it out at [www.dcom.us](http://www.dcom.us). The little time it takes to register may be worth the safety these alerts could provide. If you need assistance or do not internet at home you can sign up at one of the five libraries in Dickinson County.
