## MOWING ORDINANCE



The city has adopted a new ordinance which requires the grass height to be less than 10 inches on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> day during the months of May thru October. Residents in default will only be given 1 warning per summer season. Should a 2<sup>nd</sup> offense happen, the city will mow the property and bill the residents at a rate of \$100 per hour with a minimum of 1 hour. Please honor this ordinance and maintain your grass and weeds. A copy of the ordinance is posted at the post office or can be found on the city website. **Please also be aware that there is an ordinance in place that states grass cannot be thrown in the city streets.**
