




Get your Quasquicentennial T-shirt. T-shirts are \$12 each and are available at City Hall.



POLICE-FIRE-RESCUE

Please be sure that you have your house number on the front of your house. We want to be sure that we can easily find your house in case of an emergency. There are free numbers available at City Hall if you want them.

FALL OUTDOOR CLEAN-UP

As fall approaches we often turn to yard clean-up before the snow flies. Just a few reminders that are governed by City Ordinance.

- **Landscape waste:** The disposal by open burning of landscape waste originating on the premises is allowed
- **Burning:** Burning shall only be allowed **North** of Railroad St on **even** numbered days and **South** of Railroad St. on **odd** numbered days. Recreational fires are allowed at any time.
- **Tree Trimming:** It is the responsibility of the property owner to keep trees overhanging the streets trimmed so that all branches will be at least 15ft above the street surface
- Weed growth above 10" on your property, unlicensed/inoperable vehicles, appliances, mattresses, and junk are all items that need to be removed from your property. Call City Hall if you are unsure. **712-832-3527**




FARMERS MARKET
