FALL CLEAN-UP

As fall approaches we often turn to yard clean-up before the snow flies. Just a few reminders that are governed by City Ordinance.

- **Yard waste:** Yard waste that can be dropped off at the City shed is yard vegetation only. Landscaping block, concrete, poles, etc are not allowed.
- **Landscape waste:** The disposal by open burning of landscape waste originating on the premises is allowed.
- **Burning:** Burning shall only be allowed **North** of Railroad St on **even** numbered days and **South** of Railroad St. on **odd** numbered days. Recreational fires are allowed at any time.

WINTER REMINDER



Parking Snow Ban—Between Nov 1st and Apr 1st no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of **2:00am and 6:00am** or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for the 1st offense will be \$25. For all subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50.

Be sure to check to see if your furnace filter needs replacement. Stop in the Utility office to pick up your replacement filters. Limited sizes available. Limit 2 per year.
