CITY WIDE CLEAN-UP



The citywide clean-up is for residential areas only. All items must be placed at the curb by 7:00am. Tags must be purchased at City Hall for the following items:

- Household appliance.....\$25
- Electronics.....\$11
- Mattress & Boxspring.....\$11
- Television (based on size).....\$20 to \$30
- Computer Monitors.....\$20
- Couches & Recliners.....\$10
- Chairs, Dressers, TV Stands.....\$ 5
- Building Materials/Wood Products.\$10
- Tires (no rims).....\$5 to \$25

We ask that you please separate your items into the following groups: appliances, furniture, metal & iron, building materials. Regular household garbage will need to be in the trash carts. Metal & iron should be no longer than 10ft. Building materials should be tied into 3x3x3 bundles. All glass must be removed from windows & doors. Items that need tags will not be picked up if a tag has not been purchased.

The following items will not be accepted; toxic/flammable liquids, concrete, rocks, yard waste (grasses, flowers, etc) and tree branches.

The Miss Amazing Pageant is a non-profit organization aimed towards raising self-confidence in girls/women with disabilities. The pageant was started in Nebraska and is expanding nationwide, currently established in over 20 states. This is the fifth time the pageant has been held in Iowa. The event took place at Iowa Western Community College in Council Bluffs on February 17-18. 100 lovely ladies, ages 5-60, from all over Iowa participated. This event gives girls with disabilities the opportunity to feel like the true beauties and super stars that they are! The participants participated in interview, personal introduction, evening gown, and optional talent. These are aspects of pageantry that allow the girls to gain poise, public speaking skills, and of course, friends. To help the girls throughout the day, each contestant was paired up with a buddy that will mentor her through the day and during the final show. There were six 2017 state queens who were selected by judges, one from each age division. Lynn Murphy was awarded the title of Sr. Miss Amazing Iowa Queen. This gives her the opportunity to go to nationals and to represent the state of Iowa in Chicago IL, during the first week of August 2017.
