MOWING ORDINANCE



The city ordinance requires the grass height to be less than 10 inches on the 1st and 15th day during the months of May thru October. Residents in default will only be given 1 warning per summer season. Should a 2nd offense happen, the city will mow the property and bill the resident at a rate of \$100 per hour with a minimum of 1 hour. Please honor this ordinance and maintain your grass and weeds.

Be aware that there is also an ordinance that states that grass may not be thrown in the city streets. This helps keep the storm sewer drains from plugging.
