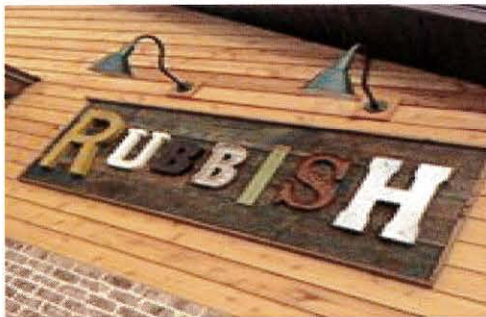




**POLICE-FIRE-RESCUE**

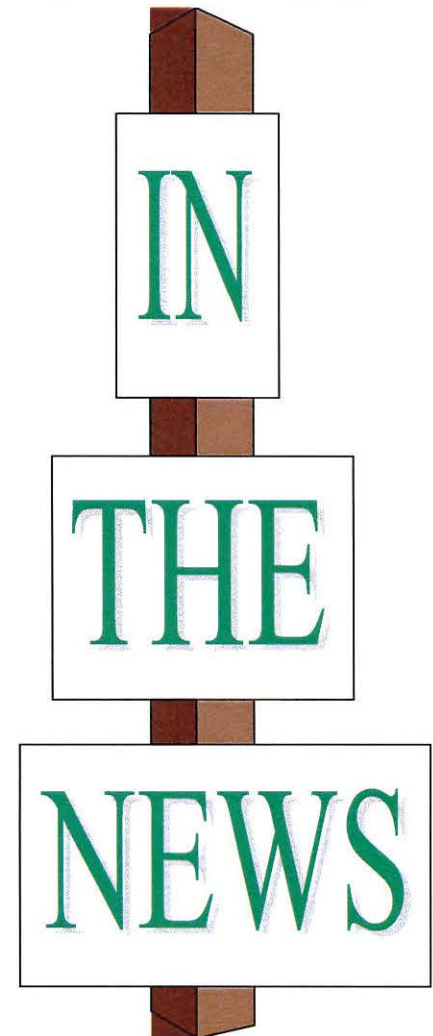

## Keep cool this summer.
