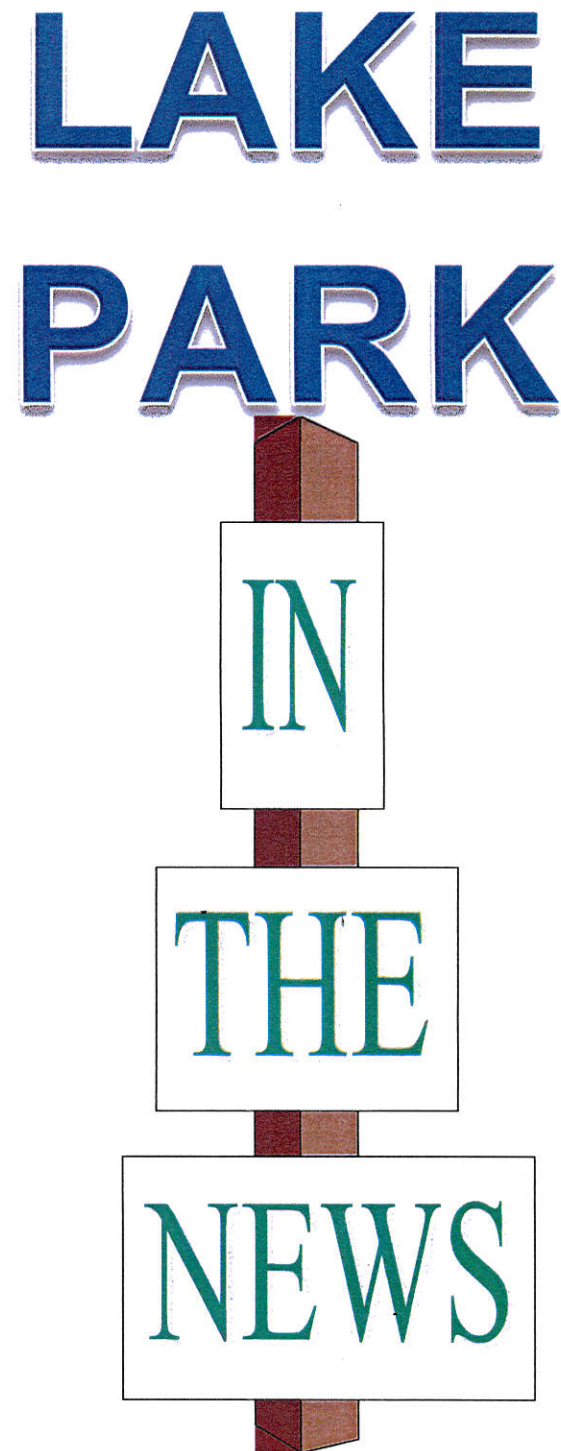

WINTER REMINDER



Parking Snow Ban—Between Nov 1st and Mar 31st no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of **2:00am and 6:00am** or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for the 1st offense will be \$25. For all other subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50.

It is a violation of city code to cause snow and ice from private property to be placed in the street.

Garbage containers are to be placed at the curb NOT on the street. Once garbage has been picked up the carts need to be moved back to your house NOT left at the curb.
