Silver Lake is an important asset to the City of Lake Park and the surrounding communities. The lake currently has high nutrient concentrations, algae blooms and undesirable fish, such as carp and buffalo. The City of Lake Park has selected the Wenck Consulting Team to evaluate the lake and its surrounding watershed to better understand the causes of the poor water quality. An important step in a successful water quality improvement project is providing information and education, building support and engaging the local community.
