**WINTER REMINDER**



**Parking Snow Ban**—Between Nov 1<sup>st</sup> and Apr 1<sup>st</sup> no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of **2:00am and 6:00am** or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for the 1<sup>st</sup> offense will be \$25. For all subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50.

Be sure to check to see if your furnace filter needs replacement. Stop in the Utility office to pick up your replacement filters. Limited sizes available. Limit 2 per year.

**It is a violation of city code to cause snow and ice from private property to be placed in the street.**

**It is the responsibility of the property owner to clear the sidewalks on Main Street in a reasonable time. Within 24 hours would be greatly appreciated.**
