CALL 811 before you dig. Whether you are building, planting a tree, putting in a fence, landscaping, tilling a garden or any type of digging; follow these three steps before you begin:

- 1. Call 811 before you dig. This will initiate the process for marking the utility lines buried in your yard. Call at least 3 days before you dig.
- 2. Wait the required time for the lines to be marked. There is no charge for this service.
- **3.** Know the flag colors: Flag colors designate the type of service buried.
 - > Red----Electric
 - > Yellow----Natural Gas
 - > Blue----Water
 - > Green---Sewer
- 4. Respect the marks, then dig with care. When you dig try to stay at least 18 inches away from the marked lines. If you must dig within the 18" do so with extreme caution and by hand.

IOWA ONE CALL 1-800-292-8989 iowaonecall.com Detecting a gas leak. Because natural gas has no scent, a strong odorant that smells like rotten eggs is added to help you detect a possible leak. If you suspect a gas leak, follow these do's and don'ts:

DO

- Make sure gas appliances are turned all the way off.
- > Smell gas? Evacuate everyone from the building or area
- > Leave the door open as you exit
- Call 712-832-3667 from a remote location
- Leave the area and stay away until someone from Lake Park Municipal Utilities allows you to return
- If you hear gas hissing or blowing, call 911

DO NOT

- > Do not try to find or repair the leak
- > Do not start an engine of any kind
- Do not strike matches or create a flame of any kind
- Do not use a telephone or cell phone (these can ignite gases or vapors)
- Do not turn on or off any light switches, garage door openers or other electrical switches (these also can ignite airborne gases)
- > Do not attempt to extinguish a burning gas leak.
