Members of the Silver Lake Steering Committee, Technical Advisory Committee and the Wenck Consulting Team have been busy reviewing past studies and information, considering new information provided by the consulting team, discussing desired lake uses and water quality goals, and considering management alternatives geared at achieving those goals.

We are now excited to get the entire Silver Lake Community together for a public meeting to discuss the current status of the planning process and gather critical input as we move toward finalizing a comprehensive plan for managing Silver Lake now and into the future. A review of the process to date, as well as recommended management activities for moving forward, will be presented.

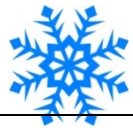

WINTER REMINDER



Parking Snow Ban—Between Nov 1st and Mar 31st no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for the 1st offense will be \$25. For all subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50.

Be sure to check to see if your furnace filter needs replacement. Stop in the Utility office to pick up your replacement filters. Limited sizes available. Limit 2 per year.
