WINTER REMINDER

Parking Snow Ban—Between Nov 1st and Mar 31st no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of **2:00am** and **6:00am** or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for the 1st offense will be \$25. For all subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50.

It is a violation of city code to shovel snow and ice from private property into the street.

It is the responsibility of the property owner to clear the sidewalks on Main Street in a reasonable amount of time. Within 24 hours would be greatly appreciated.

Garbage containers are to be placed at the curb **NOT** on the street. Once garbage has been picked up the carts need to be moved back to your house **NOT** left at the curb.
