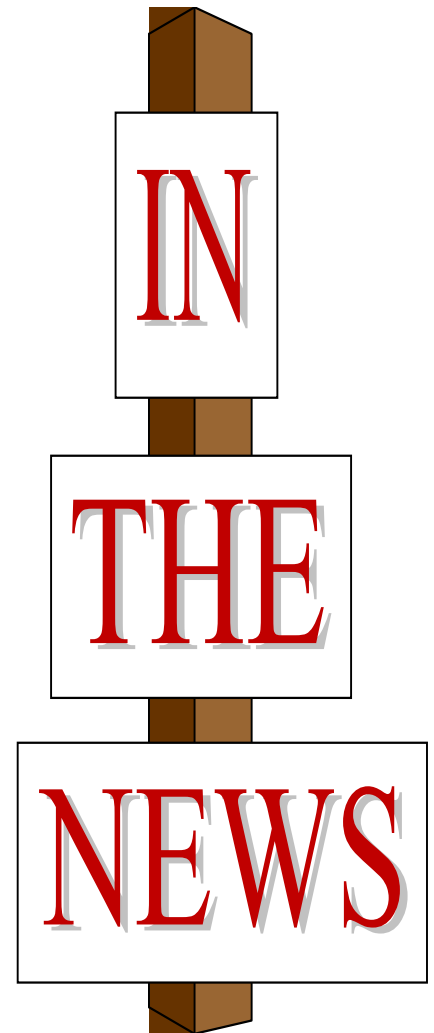

Lake Park Municipal Utilities recently received a price increase for the water that is purchased through Osceola Rural Water. Due to this price increase, the Utility Board has approved the following water rates, which take affect with the July usage.

Each customer will be billed monthly as follows:

Service Charge	\$15.00
Per 1000 gallons	\$ 7.00

There will be a minimum charge of \$15.00 for each water service account.

Second Meter Bulk rate:

Line Charge	\$18.50
Per 1000 gallons	\$ 7.00
