CENSUS 2020

It's in the Constitution....The U.S. Constitution mandates that everyone in the country be counted every 10 years. The first census was in 1790.

Your Civic Duty....Completing the census is mandatory: it's a way to participate in our democracy and say "I COUNT"

Protected Privacy.....It's against the law for the Census Bureau to publicly release your responses in any way that could identify you or your household. Your response cannot be shared with immigration enforcement agencies, law enforcement agencies or to determine eligibility for government benefits. By law, your response cannot be used against you and can only be used to produce statistics. No court of law can subpoena census responses. IT'S SAFE

Redistricting....After each decade census, state officials redraw the boundaries of the congressional and state legislative districts in their states to account for population shifts.

Your Choice.....You will have the option of responding online, by mail, or by phone. Households that don't respond will be visited by a census taker. Your response is quick and secure...in about the same amount of time as your morning coffee.

Watch for your invite to respond being mailed in March and RESPOND.

WINTER REMINDER



Parking Snow Ban—Between Nov 1st and Mar 31st no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for the 1st offense will be \$25. For all subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50.

It is a violation of city code to shovel snow and ice from private property into the street.

It is the responsibility of the property owner to clear the sidewalks on **Main Street** in a reasonable amount of time. Within **24 hours** would be greatly appreciated.

Garbage containers are to be placed at the curb **NOT** on the street. Once garbage has been picked up the carts need to be moved back to your house **NOT** left at the curb.

Be sure to check to see if your furnace filter needs replacement. Stop in the Utility office to pick up your replacement filter. Limited sizes available. Limit 2 per year.
