Just a reminder.....

1. It is unlawful for any owner to allow an animal to run at large within the city limits.
2. No owner of any animal shall cause or allow such animal to defile or defecate on any property, except the owners property, unless such owner immediately removes and disposes of all deposits by such animal.
3. It is unlawful for the owner of a dog to allow such dog serious annoyance to any person by frequent and habitual howling, yelping, barking, or by running after or chasing persons, bicycles, automobiles, or other vehicles.



APRIL 29TH CITY WIDE CLEAN UP

The city-wide clean-up is scheduled for April 29th. This clean-up is for residential areas only. All items must be placed at the curb by 7:00pm.

Tags must be purchased for the following items:

Household appliance.....	\$25
Electronics.....	\$11
Mattress/Box Spring.....	\$11
Television(based on size).....	\$20 to \$30
Computer Monitor.....	\$20
Couches & Recliners.....	\$10
Chairs/Dressers/TV Stand.....	\$ 5
Bldg Materials/Wood Products...	\$10
Tires (no rims).....	\$5 to \$25

We ask that you please separate your items in the following groups: Appliances, furniture, metal & iron, building materials. Regular household garbage will need to be in the trash carts. Metal & iron should be no longer than 10ft. Building materials should be tied in 3x3x3 bundles. All glass must be removed from windows and doors. Items that need tags will not be picked up if a tag is not purchased.

The following items **will not** be accepted; toxic/flammable liquids, concrete, rocks, brick, yard waste (grasses, flowers, etc.) and tree branches.
