2020 Census Update

Recent census data for Lake Park puts our population at 1167 which is an increase of 62 from the 2010 census. This is great news! This is a 5.6% increase. The average for cities of our size was -2.1%. Some state and federal funding is based on population, which will allow us to see some increases in funding.

2021-2022 HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEN TO APPLY:

- * Elderly (60 & Over) & disabled:
Oct. 1, 2021 to Apr. 30, 2022
- * All other households:
Nov. 1, 2021 to Apr. 30, 2022

WHAT TO TAKE

- * Proof of Income (for all household members age 19 & over) Depending upon your household income type, income documentation from the past 30 days, last 12 months, or last calendar year, whichever is easier or more beneficial for you.
- * Social Security numbers for all household members (documentation required)
- * Most recent heat bill
- * Most recent electric bill

WAGE EARNERS

- * Bring copies of your check stubs for the 30-day period preceding the date of application, or a copy of your most recent federal income tax return

FIXED INCOME

- * This income may include: Social Security Benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Family Investment Program, Veteran's Assistance, Unemployment Insurance, and pensions. Bring copies of your check stubs from the previous 30 days.

SELF-EMPLOYED FARMERS

- * Bring a copy of your most recent federal income tax return

FIP RECIPIENTS

- * Bring your current DHS Notice of Decision or contact your local office for document information.

CITY REMINDER

Your home and property are one of the greatest assets you will ever own. Here are a few things that your property **IS NOT**

1. It is not a prairie, hence the need to keep it mowed; including weeds.
2. It is not a used car lot or parts junkyard. Both of those require a special sales permit. Vehicles not being used need to be removed from the property. Same with vehicle parts. They can be there for 30 days as long as they are used for repair within that 30 days.
3. Your yard is not an open storage unit. The ordinance has limited items that can be stored in the side and back yard. There is not any storage allowed in the front yard. This includes trailers, boats, campers..etc. Check the ordinance. There are storage units available for rent!
