## WINTER REMINDER

**Parking Snow Ban**--Between Nov 1<sup>st</sup> and Mar 31<sup>st</sup> no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am or at any time during the day or night which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for 1<sup>st</sup> offense will be \$25. For all subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50

It is the responsibility of the property owner to clear the sidewalks on Main Street in a reasonable amount of time. Within **24 hours** would be greatly appreciated

**Dumping of Snow**--It is unlawful for any person to throw, push, place, or cause to be thrown, pushed, or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the traveled way of a street or alley.

Garbage containers are to be placed at the curb, **not** on the street. Once garbage has been picked up the carts need to be moved back to your house **not** left at the curb.

Be sure to check if your furnace filter needs replacement. Stop in the Utility office to pick up your replacement filter. Limit 2 per year.


