FALL CLEANUP

As fall approaches, we often turn to yard cleanup before the snow flies. Just a few reminders:

Grass, leaves, yard waste

DO NOT put this waste in the garbage bins or dumpsters. There is a drop-off spot located at the city shed. The disposal of waste, originating on the premises, by open burning is allowed.

Burning

Yard waste burning shall only be allowed north of Railroad St. on even numbered days and south of Railroad St. on odd numbered days.

Recreational fires are allowed at any time.

Residential waste may be burned between the hours of 7am-7pm, north of Railroad St. on the even numbered days and south of Railroad St. on the odd numbered days. Burning is required to be contained in a burn barrel with a screen or cover.
