

SAFETY TIPS



Snow and ice can damage or block natural gas meters and exhaust fan vents for appliances. Chimneys and vents on the roof or side of a building must be clear to allow proper venting which prevents equipment malfunction or accumulation of **carbon monoxide**.

Install carbon monoxide alarms and carefully follow the mfg. directions for operation, placement, and maintenance. **Keep your family safe! Get a CO detector installed.**

Do you smell the odor of rotten eggs, hear hissing or whistling sounds around gas appliances or meter? These may be signs of a natural gas leak. Contact LPMU 712-832-3667.



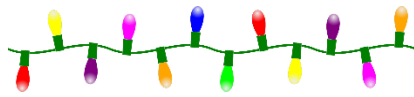
Be sure to keep me clear of snow or else I will stop regulating and you will be without heat.

WINTER REMINDER

Parking Snow Ban—Between Nov 1st and Mar 31st no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for 1st offense will be \$25. For all subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50.

Dumping of Snow—It is unlawful for any person to throw, push, place, or csude to be thrown, pushed, or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the traveled way of a street or alley.

Be sure to check if your furnace filter needs replacement. Stop in the utility office to pick up your replacement filters. Limited sizes available. Limit 2 per year.
