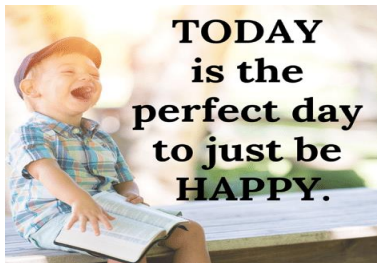
LPMU offers ACH payment of your utility bill. Your bill will automatically be withdrawn on the 7<sup>th</sup> of the month. Set up at the utility office.

Utility bills can be paid by credit/debit card online through AllPaid on the city website. AllPaid will charge you a fee for using this service.

## Reminder

The can trailer for the Silver Lake Country Club (SLCC) is a fundraiser to generate money for the future clubhouse in Lake Park. To help make the SLCC Can Recycle more efficient and effective the following conditions must be followed.

1. Absolutely **No Glass**. Please take glass to the City recycling.
2. **No milk or water jugs**. These need to go to the City recycling
3. **No Garbage or Trash** and please **No** chew containers ...these are trash
4. Cans and plastic bottles need to be in separate "Clear" plastic bags.

If you need clear plastic bags to separate cans from plastic bottles, stop by Niemeier Chiropractic and we will give you a few for free. This can be a great money stream for the SLCC but the additional labor to sort the drop-offs has proven labor intensive.

## WINTER REMINDER

**Parking Snow Ban**—Between Nov 1<sup>st</sup> and Mar 31<sup>st</sup> no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for 1<sup>st</sup> offense will be \$25. For all subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50.
