

Sewer Rate Increase

The new sewer plant has been in operation since last fall. Thank you to those who stopped out at the open house to view how it operates. An additional increase in the sewer rate will take effect July 1, which means the increase will be seen on the July usage bill. The new rates will be:

Monthly Service fee:	\$22.13
Per 1000 gals. Water	\$10.40
Capital Improvement fee	\$29.00

As a city we will do all that we can to keep cost as low as possible and run the plant as efficient as we can. We will have a much better idea of actual costs when the loan closes, and we have a year of operation cost under our belt. At which time we will be reviewing the rates. We will continually review rates.

REMINDER: It is against city ordinance to connect a roof downspout, sump pump, foundation drain, areaway drain, or other surface run-off or groundwater to a building sewer or building drain that is connected directly or indirectly to a public sanitary sewer.

Golf Cart Rules

3. Safety flag required
4. Sunrise to sunset operation
