

WINTER REMINDER



Parking Snow Ban—Between Nov 1st and Mar 31st no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of **2:00am and 6:00am** or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for the 1st offense will be \$25. For all other subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50.

It is a violation of city code to cause snow and ice from private property to be placed in the street.

It is the responsibility of the property owner to clear the sidewalks on Main Street in a reasonable amount of time. Within 24 hours would be greatly appreciated.

Be sure to check to see if your furnace filter needs replacement. Stop in the Utility office to pick up your replacement filters. Limited sizes available. Limit 2 per year.

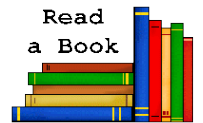

Story Time is the first Saturday of each month starting at 10:30. Bring your preschoolers in for stories and a craft each month!

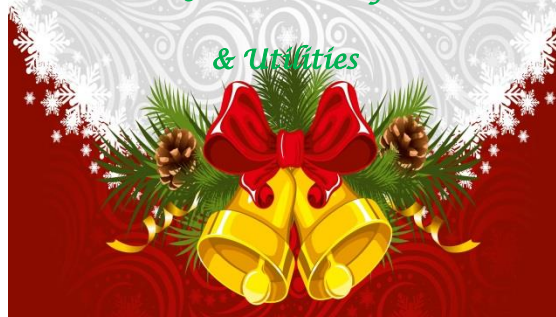
Our Adult Book Club meets the 3rd Tuesday of each month at 4:00. Everyone is welcome.
